Entries must follow all of the rules and regulations. The Heart of Wisconsin Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to remove entrants from the parade at any time if they are not following the guidelines and/or are refusing to follow instructions from parade officials.

- All entries must be approved by the Parade Committee before entering the parade line.
- All entries must be in place by 11:15AM. The person signing the application must be present at the time of float inspection.
- It is the responsibility of each entry to maintain a safe distance from the float ahead of them,
 while still working to prevent lags and delays in the parade.
- Throwing of candy or any objects from parade entrants will not be allowed. Handing out candy or objects to the crowd is permitted by WALKERS ONLY.
- Individuals and organizations are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times.
- It is the responsibility of parents/guardians with children participating in the parade to make necessary arrangements for children to be met and picked up when the parade is finished.
- Deadline for parade entries is May 23rd, 2022. An additional fee will apply if an form arrives past that date.
- Fire extinguishers are strongly suggested to be on every float for safety reasons.
- No one is allowed to get on or off a float or entry once it has started down the parade route.
- No participant is allowed to have a loaded firearm at any time.
- No smoking or possession/consumption of alcoholic beverages at any time before or during the parade.
- Anyone wishing to ride a horse in the parade must be affiliated with or riding in an approved group.
- All entrants must be decorated.
- If playing music, please play it loudly to ensure parade attendees can hear it. As a courtesy other participants, please refrain from playing music until the parade begins.

Entrants must sign the bottom of parade registration form to confirm they understand and agree to the stated policies.

All entrants will receive a confirmation with further details as the event date approaches.
